HELP Keep our landfill open by following these guides. We accept <u>no liquids, in</u> <u>any container!</u> We only accept KDHE permitted Hazardous waste No liquids.

All Chemical jugs are to be triple rinsed when emptied.

Things to remember when putting trash into dumpsters. Whether City, Commercial rented, or private!!

Not acceptable items for Dumpsters or trash truck are listed below.

- 1. Appliances (Refrigerators, Ovens, Washing Machines Dryers and more)
- 2. Concrete any amounts
- 3. Tires of any kind
- 4. Large limbs or trees
- 5. Liquids NOT ACCEPTED ANY TIME !!!! Oil, Paint, Fuel, Chemicals, etc.
- 6. Large Exercise equipment.
- 7. Metal
- 8. WE ACCEPT NO RAIL ROAD TIES.
- 9. Tarps used for Agricultural storage

Exception would be if commercial or private dumpster only contains 1 of the above listed items. Example concrete in one, or metal in one, or agricultural tarps in one... **NO LIQUIDS**

Materials that have to be separated

Commercial dumpsters and individual trailers, pickups etc.

- 1. All Metal (WE Charge for anything with freon), (Refrigerators and Freezers must be empty of all items inside.)
- 2. Trees & Brush (no lumber products i.e., fencing, boards, post, panels, etc. In trees & Brush Pile) Trees and branch pieces are to be no longer than 6 feet in length. No whole trees!
- 3. Concrete & Brick
- 4. Asphalt
- 5. Tires (We charge on all tires by size and type, no charge on those cuts into thirds or with sidewalls cut out)
 - C&D (Construction and demolition) materials should adhere to above guides. Individual household and business trash will adhere to above rules.

ANY LOADS NOT SEPERATED UPON ARRIVAL WILL BE SEPERATED AS DIRECTED - OR WILL BE REFUSED. WE ACCEPT NO RAILROAD TIES!

Agricultural Plastic is accepted and there is a fee for dumping it.
